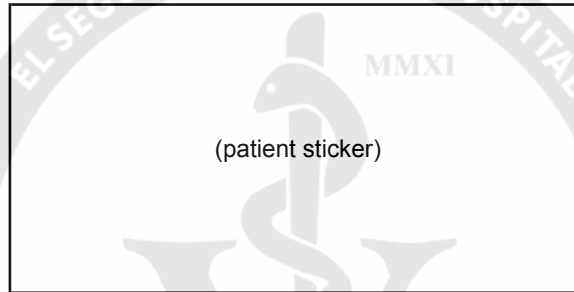

## CLIENT INFORMATION: ALLERGIC DERMATITIS - CATS



### CAUSES

1. Atopy (environmental: anything)
2. Diet (chicken is the primary protein cause)
3. Ectoparasites (fleas)

### MEDICATIONS

#### STEROIDS / PREDNISONONE

PHYSIOLOGIC dose 0.1 - 0.4 mg/kg is what the body produces  
the dosing range for Prednisone for use as an ANTI-INFLAMMATORY is 0.5 - 0.9 mg/kg/day  
the dose for Prednisone as an IMMUNOSUPPRESSIVE is greater than 1 mg/kg/day

#### ADDITIONAL MEDICATIONS

1. Apoquel
2. Atopica

### DIETARY RECOMMENDATIONS
